The “Rokkasho Public Library” is a public library attached to the Rokkasho Village Cultural Exchange Plaza "Swany". In 1997, it was put into operation at the same time as Suwanee. The collection is about 45,000 volumes, which is relatively large for a village library. In addition to the learning corner, there is also a DVD viewing corner, which is familiar to many users every day.



Rokkasho Museum – Jomon Period Learning Center –

The “Rokkasho Museum” was built in August 1991 with the main purpose of protecting and preserving Jomon period artifacts discovered during excavations associated with large-scale developments such as the Mutsu-Ogawara development. In order for the region to understand correctly, we classify them into archaeology, nature, and ethnicity, and strive to display them in an easy-to-understand manner. In addition, there are many events that are held and many people from inside and outside the village visit throughout the year.
